COOKIE POLICY

INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We are committed to keeping the use of cookies to a minimum. However some are necessary to the functioning of the website and to make the experience easier for you. We only use:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that remembers certain pages of the website.
- **Analytical/performance cookies.** They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our website.

You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

Cookie	Purpose of Cookie	More information	When Cookie expires
bp-activity-oldestpage	On the Activity page, rather than the list of activity being paginated, it has a “load more” button. The “bp-activity-oldestpage” cookie remembers what page of activity the “load more” is on.	Link	When the browsing session ends
wordpress_logged_in_	After login, Wordpress sets the wordpress_logged_in_[hash] cookie, which indicates when you're logged in, and who you are, for most interface use.	Link	When the browsing session ends
wordpress_sec_	Contains the user’s unique session ID in order to maintain the user’s state (eg. logged in/out) and any related preferences/settings.	Link	When the browsing session ends
wordpress_test_cookie	Used on sites built with Wordpress. Tests whether or not the browser has cookies enabled WordPress sets this cookie when you navigate to the login page. The cookie	Link Link	When the browsing session ends
